On October 5, 2010, a Special Membership meeting will be held to vote on the project.

Aerifying Greens: We will be aerifying the greens immediately after the Labor Day Tournament. We will be using small tines and dry sand which should result in minimal disruption to the putting surface and speed recovery. Thank you for your understanding.

Lying Down on the Job: One new pine tree at the top of the hill on #2 champ refuses to stay standing. For the 3rd time since it was planted, it has tipped over. It is probably dead, but we will stand it up one more time this time using 8 stakes instead of 4.

LT: If it doesn't rain on Monday, we will be light topdressing in the morning.

3 To Go: We have only 3 bunkers on the Champ left to edge. Then on to the Cameron!

Still Trimming: We will continue trimming the valve boxes, green-side sprinklers and the rest of the long list are areas the mowers can't reach.

Drying: If the weather permits, we will be drying sand this week in prep for the fall aerifications.
