

## *Buffalo Hill Golf Club - Memorial Program:*

The purpose of the BHGC Memorial Program is to give individuals or organizations an avenue to remember and honor loved ones who have passed away. The details of the program are as follows:

- Permanent recognition will be made in the form of listing the individuals or organizations making the memorial, and who it is remembering on the memorial plaque to be located in the trophy case area in the main clubhouse. Further recognition will be made in the BHGC newsletter and listed in the Memorial link on the BHGC website.
- Memorials or gifts of \$250 or more will be recognized and engraved on the Memorial Plaque and placed inside this case. Memorial funds raised will be used for the BHGC tree fund or general capital improvement fund as requested by donor.
- **Note:** All existing memorial markers on the grounds of BHGC will remain on the course. All future memorial markers will fall into the above guidelines.

Supervision of the Memorial Program will be the responsibility of the Memorial Committee with the assistance of the General Manager, PGA Golf Professional and Golf Course Superintendent.

## *Hall of Fame Program:*

The purpose of the BHGC Hall of Fame is to honor and perpetuate the efforts of those persons who have distinguished themselves by their contribution to Buffalo Hill Golf Club and the game of golf. The details of the program are as follows:

- Individuals may be nominated for induction to the BHGC Hall of Fame for excellence in any or all of the following categories: competitive playing accomplishments, junior golf promotion or outstanding contributions of time or capital towards advancement of golf at BHGC.
- The Memorial Committee will review all nominations and approve up to (2) per calendar year. **Note:** The Memorial Committee may decide to approve more than (2) nominations in the first year to establish the Hall of Fame.
- Permanent recognition will be made in the form of listing the individual(s) selected on the Hall of Fame plaque, with a notation on what category they were recognized in, to be located in the trophy case in the main clubhouse. A short bio of the selected individuals will also accompany the plaque in which the Hall of Fame selections will be engraved.

Supervision of the Hall of Fame Program will be the responsibility of the Memorial Committee with the assistance of the General Manager and PGA Professional.
