



Buffalo Hill to Open Cameron 9 on Friday



COVID-19 - Procedures while at BHGC:

As the Cameron 9 opens this Friday in a limited capacity, Buffalo Hill is thankful to be opening and will take all the necessary precautions to provide a clean and safe environment.

After adopting procedures and guidelines from the PGA and CDC, here is what you'll need to know at Buffalo Hill...

In the clubhouse:

- Only the golf shop will be open.
- No more than 2 guests in the golf shop at a time.
- The outdoor restroom will be the only restroom available as the clubhouse is closed.
- Shop hours through the end of March will be 9:00 – 6:00 PM.

On the course:

- The Cameron 9 will be by tee time only to reduce crowd sizes.

- Every 4th tee time will be left open to provide proper spacing on the golf course.
- Members may call the golf shop or send one person from their group to check-in.
- Guests may call the golf shop to pay for their round, or check in at the pro shop.
- Carts are allowed.
- Tee times start at 10:00 AM, weather permitting.

On the range:

- Range balls will be staged at each hitting station.
- Range balls can be paid for in the golf shop unless you have a range pass.
- Due to limited space, we ask you to consider others that may be waiting to hit balls.
- Range hours will be 10:00 – 6:00 this week and will change as weather improves.

In general:

- Practice proper social distancing while at the golf course,
- If you feel sick, please stay at home.
- Help us keep the golf course clean and safe for our community.
- Do not spend any more time in the pro shop than necessary.

With the Cameron 9 opening this week and the Championship 18 soon to follow (TBA) everyone will soon be able to enjoy some social distancing on the golf course. It will be great to get back on the golf course, but for a while, Buffalo Hill will have to operate with reduced services. We are following recommended guidelines to mitigate risks and provide the safest environment possible.
