As you are aware, we are keeping the rakes off the course because we are trying to minimize touching points. That said, to slightly help the playability, please use your foot or sand wedge to level out the area where we dig our feet in and from where you've perfectly hit your ball from.

Please keep carts on paths when you are close to the greens, and at least 30' from the front of any green. We put rope and stakes up to help with turf quality in areas which is and or has been compromised by heavy cart traffic.
