From the General Manager:

May ended with a one of the worst destructive storms in the history of Buffalo Hill Golf Course. At last count, we lost 41 trees of varying size throughout the course. Most notably uprooted, and I mean a *massive* root ball and all, is one of the towering ponderosa trees on #18, and one of the tall poplar trees on the right hand side of #18. In addition, Mother Nature's wrath took down 12 trees on the Cameron 9 - and one that took down power lines on north main street along #8 fairway.

As a result of this storm, lack of power, and trees that need to be removed, the golf course and clubhouse will be closed on Monday. In the event Flathead Electric is able to restore power by 11:00 Monday morning, we WILL continue with the Ladies

Clinics Monday evening. Keep an eye on our website message board for updates.

Finally, as you'll see below, Chef Carl is excited to offer an "after hours" food menu starting Tuesday, June 2. While we understand COVID-19 has affected everybody in the Flathead Valley, we'd like to offer the after hours menu to serve our members and guests. Now that the range is off the mats, it would be beneficial to all who use the range to fill as many of your divots that you can. By filling them it will help ensure we continue to have grass to hit off of. That also rolls into the golf course. Please fill your divots or replace turf if possible.

FYI.... per Governor's directive, rakes are still not allowed on the course. Your help in flattening dug in foot areas will allow for better play-ability from the bunkers. Thank you for your help!

A last minute blast regarding the significant wind Sunday morning. The course will look a bit different - and in areas that I would have not wanted changes to improve play or the look of the golf hole. We had **over 40 trees** significantly damaged by the winds. A huge majority of these were full root ball and tree blow over. We will do our very best to remove the tons of debris and trees in order to open the course. At this point, our primary concern is safety of players, therefore the course is closed until power is restored and we can establish it is safe to play. The main gate will also be closed for safety.
