Relief Granted! Moving forward, we will implement another **local rule** regarding the "**native grass areas**" which are defined as any un-mowed grass areas in excess of 6" tall. If your ball comes to rest in any of these areas, you may proceed under Rule 17.1.

Each player will have **four options**:

1. Play the ball as it lies.
2. Take relief two club lengths from the reference point,

- no closer to the hole. (1 stroke penalty)
3. Take relief anywhere on a straight line from the pin through the reference point, no closer to the hole. (1 stroke penalty)
4. Replay original shot. (1 stroke penalty)
