Repair and Divots!



From the Golf Course Superintendent:

Another question asked is this: "Is it better to fill your divot with sand and seed or replace your divot?" Well, it depends on time of year and how big and deep the divot. During summer months it's typically better to fill with sand and seed unless you take a big, deep, divot. Those deep divots will grow back. Spring and fall seasons - it's always good to put the turf back.

PLEASE, DO NOT TAKE DIVOTS OUT OF GREENS! It's not the greens fault you missed a putt - right? It's your fault because you made a bad stroke or a bad read. So please, if you need to hit something, hit yourself. DO NOT DAMAGE THE COURSE AND RUIN IT FOR ALL THE OTHER PEOPLE PLAYING BEHIND YOU. I know that 98% of the golfers KNOW this, but it's just that 2% that seem to need a little reminder. THANK YOU for understanding.

Ball marks (pitch marks) should always be repaired! Do not pry up the roots or soil up, pull in from the edges of said ball mark. By pulling in it will heal with in 48 hours, by pulling roots or soil up, it will take weeks to heal.
