From the General Manager:

Good morning!

Everybody enjoying a warm, beautiful October so far? Temperatures in the 70's with crystal clear skies and vibrant fall colors - it doesn't get any better than this. It looks like we're in for more of the same for a few more days, so get out there and enjoy the great game of golf with friends and family.

If you haven't heard, Lee Terry, Greens Committee Chairman and former Golf Course Superintendent (at courses across the country!) and Superintendent Mike Combs have evaluated the effectiveness of the greens covers over the years. They have concluded that covering greens at BHGC is, at best, "questionable." Mr. Terry points out that there are winters that we would have been better off without the covers - there's just no

compelling data that supports the covers are effective. Mike noted that with so many of the covers beyond their useful life (tears and holes) it's time to see how we can better manage the greens during the winter months through strategic snow and ice removal. Therefore, the greens will not be covered this winter.

The good news is that without the covers, all 27 holes will remain open after October 31st, which was typically the course closing date when covers were used. Carts will also be allowed. More details on November golf later in the month.

As announced through a special e-mail message on Saturday, the 2021 fees and rates were set by the KGA Board of Directors at the September 30th BOD meeting.
